Hi Mark

I have just been speaking with Jo Searle and she raised the issue of the lack of information provided on some of the applications submitted by PT regarding claims of harm and name of institution in which abuse/neglect occurred. She also advised that on a recent occasion, one of her staff received a less than helpful response from a PT officer during a discussion to try and obtain more information about a client's experience of harm.

Given this and in light of Mark Crofton's email comment that "*many if not all clients would otherwise qualify for redress scheme payments are unable to provide a full account, if they are able to provide any account at all of any possible claims that they might have against the State for abuse suffered whilst in State care as minors*" I have asked Jo to attend this afternoon's meeting. She will bring some examples of the type of information provided by PT officers when applying for their clients. – I hope this okay with you.
