

Queensland Multicultural Resource Directory and Stakeholder Database Guidelines

The Department of Communities, Child Safety and Disability Services through Multicultural Affairs Queensland publishes the Queensland Multicultural Resource (QMR) Directory, which has contact information for government and non-government services, and diverse cultural groups/communities. Multicultural Affairs Queensland also maintains an on-line Stakeholder Database on its website.

The QMR Directory and on-line Stakeholder Database facilitates liaisons between non-government and government agencies, enhance community access to services, and showcase the cultural diversity in Queensland.

Organisations listed on the Directory are responsible for providing Multicultural Affairs Queensland with any updates or changes to their contact information so that these can be reflected in the Directory and on-line Stakeholder Database on the Multicultural Affairs Queensland website.

To add or update contact information, the organisation needs to complete the Multicultural resource directory and community database update form.

- diverse cultural groups in Queensland
- local government organisations
- non-government community services
- government services
- relevant not-for-profit organisations

Multicultural Affairs Queensland maintains the right to reject or omit an organisation from the Queensland Multicultural Resource Directory if it is deemed unsuitable for publication. The organisation will be notified in writing by Multicultural Affairs Queensland.
